The Wheelhouse is a two-storey guest house with nine en-suite rooms. Five rooms are located on the ground floor, although there is no level access to the building thus limiting disabled access. Arriving at The Wheelhouse

The Wheelhouse is located in Hugh Town on St. Mary's, the largest of the five inhabited islands that comprise the Isles of Scilly. The Islands are reached by fixed-wing plane or boat. All flights are met by minibuses that will drop passengers off by the Wheelhouse. Accessible transit is possible by prior arrangement. When arriving by boat all luggage labelled 'The Wheelhouse' will be delivered directly to The Wheelhouse by Island Carriers for a small charge (£1.40 per item for 2017 season). The Wheelhouse is just a short walk from the main quay. Taxi transfers can be arranged if required.

We are in close proximity to Hugh Town's shops, restaurants, cafes, galleries and the main quay, from where the passenger boats arrive and depart.

The Wheelhouse is accessed from a gently sloping tarmac road leading to Porthcressa beach. The path to the front door is concrete and has a slight incline. The doorframe has an 80mm high step which must be stepped over. The doorframe is 740mm wide. A mobility scooter can be parked on the front path, though this area is uncovered. Golf buggies are available for hire on St. Mary's from the Scilly Cart Company, please contact us for details.

We offer to take your luggage to and from your room.

Communal areas

All communal areas are carpeted. Directly in front of the main entrance is the door to the lounge/dining room. This is a 760mm wide fire door. The lounge area is available for use at any time and has armchair seating for 11 people and a selection of local interest books. Rooms 6 & 7 are located up a flight of 12 steps accessed from the lounge. The steps are each approximately 200mm high. There is a minimum head clearance of 1600mm on this staircase.

To the right of the entrance hall is the corridor leading to rooms 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 & 9 and the downstairs WC. There are two steps up to the corridor, 130mm and 117mm high respectively. Ground floor rooms 1, 2 & 3 and the WC are accessed from this section of corridor at ground floor level. The door to the WC is some 610mm wide. Rooms 4 and 5 are up a flight of 13 stairs, each approximately 210mm high. The staircase is 760m wide. The corridor then goes through an open doorway, some 560mm wide. Room 9 is accessed from this corridor. Room 8 is at a right hand turn at the end of the corridor. There is a step down, which is raised by 42mm and steps down 155mm. Room 8 is opposite the rear fire exit.

The breakfast buffet table is 740mm high. All hot food and drink is served by table service.

The rooms

Room 1

Ground floor twin with en-suite shower. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 2

Ground floor double with en-suite shower. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 3

Ground floor double with en-suite shower. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 4

First floor small double with en-suite bath and electric shower over the bath. Side of bath is 550mm high. Has an external door on to first floor deck. Headroom restricted adjacent to bed due to slope of ceiling. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 5

First floor double with en-suite bath and electric shower over the bath. Side of bath is 430mm high. Has an external door on to first floor deck. Headroom marginally restricted adjacent to bed due to slope of ceiling. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 6

First floor double with en-suite shower. Has an external door on to first floor deck. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 7

First floor double with en-suite shower. Has an external door on to first floor deck. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 8

Ground floor single/twin with en-suite shower. There is a large step, 235mm, up to the shower room. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Room 9

Ground floor single with en-suite shower. Electric heater. Carpet in room, vinyl tiles in en-suite.

Garden/patio

The patio is available for use by residents at all times. The patio is accessed from the front path, up a 190mm high step. It is constructed of concrete and has an even surface. There are four tables on the patio with seating for 12.

The garden is available for use by residents. The garden is located facing the beach. To access the garden you must leave the guest house and head down the concrete public highway for a few metres, which has a slight down slope. There is a small step of 20mm to reach the garden gate. The gate is some 2200mm wide and operated by a bolt into the gatepost on the inside of the gate. The other side of the gate is a concrete area with some pot plants on it. There is a 230mm step up to the lawn area.

Fire safety

Strictly a non smoking guest house. Fire alarm system with sounders in each guest room and main communal rooms that is tested on a weekly basis. Emergency lighting system that is tested weekly. External exits in all upstairs rooms that lead on to the first floor deck. There is a fire exit opposite room 8. Fire doors to prevent spread of fire. Each guest room has information about fire exit routes.
